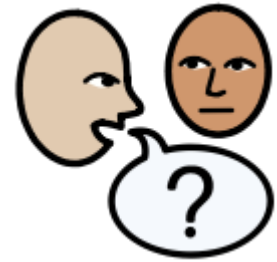


How to...

Use asking for help visuals



Lots of children have difficulties asking for help when they have not understood. There are lots of ways to support children to develop this skill.

Whole class strategy:

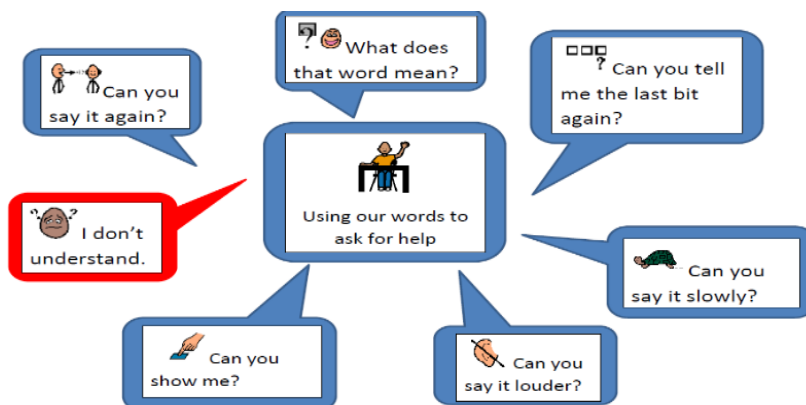
After you explain the task, ask the class to put their heads down on the desk and close their eyes. Ask them to use their thumbs to tell the adult if they have understood, not sure or not understood.

Asking for help poster:

- Display the poster below in class and refer to it throughout the day.
- Adults can model the use of phrases to ask of help, e.g., 'you could say, what does X mean?'

Personalised Visuals:

- Try using cards with students that have difficulty asking for help.
- Practise using in games outside the classroom.
- Give praise and feedback when they use the cards.
