# How to... Teach New Vocabulary





Learning vocabulary is key to language development and accessing the curriculum.

One approach for teaching vocabulary is the 'Word Aware' STAR principle.

## Select the word

- Think about topics or interests which may be used regularly.
- Choose different types of words e.g. objects (nouns), action words (verbs), and describing words (adjectives).
- Use achievable words that are not too hard or too easy.
  - E.g. Plant (not chlorophyll [too hard] or sun [too easy])

# Teach the word

- 1) Write/draw the word
- 2) Has the child heard this before?
- 3) Use a word web →
- 4) What sounds are in the word?
- 5) What does the word mean?
- 6) Include the new words in a game
- 7) Put the word in a sentence
- 8) Create a word bank or word wall of new words

# Activate the word

- Encourage use of the word.
  - E.g. Create a poster to remind and prompt the child

### Review the word

- Have regular opportunities to re-visit learnt words.
  - E.g. Create a 'word pot' and pull out the target words to ask the children if they can remember the word and its meaning.
