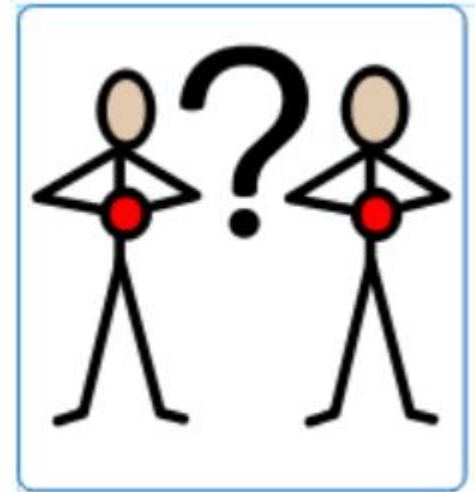


How to...

Use a Turn-Taking Board



How to use a Turn-Taking Board...

Place pictures or written names of each player in an alternate order on the turn-taking board.

Discuss the board and whose turn will be first and next...

“First it is ...’s turn”

“Next it is ...’s turn”

Play the game, labelling whose turn it is throughout.

Comment when a turn has finished...

“...’s turn has finished”

“Now it’s ...’s turn”

And cross out or move the name/visual on the turn-taking board to match your verbal language

Praise the child for waiting when it’s not their turn

“Good waiting”

Top Tips

- Consider if written names or pictures will be best
- Introduce the turn-taking board for the first time in pairs
- Change who goes first each time

Making it Easier

- Use a turn-taking song
- Use the same language consistently
- Use a countdown at the end of a turn

Making it Harder

- Have a bigger group
- Reduce your support
- Use the board in more activities
