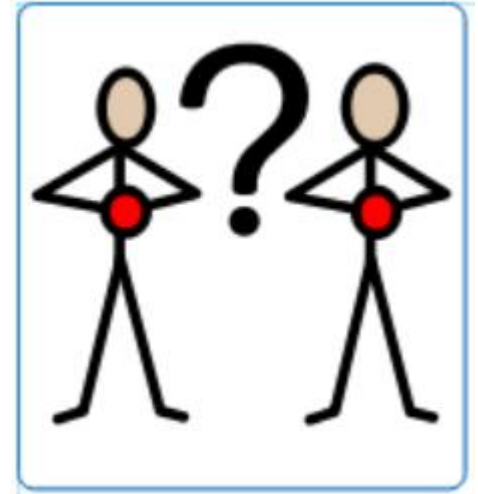

A Turn-Taking Board?



Why do we need to learn

how to take turns?

- To help us to share with others
- To help us to learn how to wait

What is a Turn-Taking Board?

- A simple visual board to help a child learn to understand when it is their turn
 - o The board can have a 'start' (green) and 'finish' (red) column, where we move photos to show who to have a turn and when to wait.
 - o The board could be a written list where the child's name is crossed off each time their turn has finished.
 - o The board could combine written names and photos, where the child puts their name and/or photo in the pouch when their turn has finished.
