

What is Using Visualisation to support Understanding?

Using Visualisation to support Understanding supports children and young people (CYP) to:

- Describe an image in relation to a range of adjectives.
- Visualise an image to recall and remember information.
- Identify whether information is provided or inferred/predicted.
- Predict and use inference when using visuals and pictures.

Key Information:

- Who is it for? CYP aged Year 5 upwards.
- How many children can be in a group? 3-5 children.
- How long is a group? 30 minutes Weekly over a 6-week period.

What do I need?

- Photographs or a Class Text
- Feature Prompts
- Monitoring Form

- Aids CYP to remember and understand what they have heard or read.
- Aids CYP to identify words that they don't understand.
