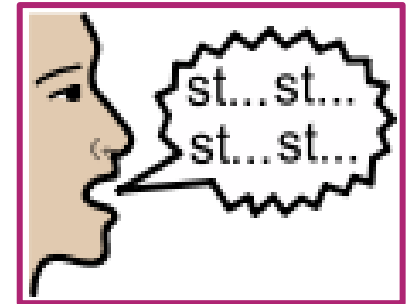


Biborough School Aged Stammering Service

Who is this service for?

Children & Young People Aged 7+ with a Biborough (Westminster & Kensington & Chelsea) GP.



Who can refer?

We accept referrals from the Biborough GPs or local SLTs.

What will happen?

- When the referral is received, parents/ carers will be asked to complete a questionnaire about their child's stammer.
- On completion of the questionnaire, families will then be offered an initial assessment with the SLT.
- Following the assessment, the SLT will write a report and discuss options for therapy with you.

What therapy do you offer?

- The therapy offered is dependent on information gathered from the assessment.
- It is important that parents/ carers are directly involved in therapy.
- Coming to therapy is not about 'curing' or 'treating' the stammer, but supporting children and young people to be confident communicators and support families to further understand stammering.
