## Study Skills: Understanding Key Vocabulary

## How to identify key vocabulary:

- Look at subject glossaries to see what vocabulary you need.
- Highlight key words according to the subject or topic.
- Look up any key exam words so that you can understand exam questions.


## Top tips to unpick and learn key vocabulary:

The more you know about a word, the more likely you are to fully understand it, retain it, and be able to use it again.

When learning new vocabulary, think about:

- The meaning of the word
- Have you heard the word in any contexts before?
- Does the word have multiple meanings?
- Can you use a symbol or picture to make this visual?
- The context
- When might you use this word?
- Practice using in a sentence.


## Top tips to remember key vocabulary:

- Give words an action - what does the word make you think of.
- Record the word in your workbook/ your flashcards/ your word pot so you can come back and review.
